INTEGRATE HEALTH

PROJECT: Ending Preventable Deaths of Women and Children in Togo, West Africa

ALLOCATION: \$124,927 | FISCAL YEAR: 2020



Healthcare

In Togo, a West African nation on the Gulf of Guinea, 49% of the population lives on less than \$1.90 per day, 368 women die for every 100,000 live births, and nearly one in ten children will not live to see their fifth birthday. The majority of these deaths are from diseases that are entirely treatable at

very low costs, like malaria, diarrhea, and pneumonia.

Unfortunately, Togo lacks the functioning healthcare system required to deliver effective treatments to women and children in need. Essential healthcare systems, including personnel, supplies, and training, are currently absent or insufficient throughout much of the country. As a result, 70% of Togo's population, nearly six million people, live without access to adequate healthcare.

The mission of Integrate Health is to make primary healthcare accessible to all. Integrate Health works alongside governments and local communities to implement and study their Integrated Primary Care program in order to achieve universal health coverage.

By integrating professional Community Health Workers with improved care in public clinics, their approach creates a patient-centered health system that is accountable to the community and dramatically reduces mortality in severely resource-limited settings.

"When my three children were sick at the same time, I was afraid because I didn't think I could afford care. A community health worker came to my house and explained

her job. I was anxious at first but was obliged to trust her. She diagnosed all three children with malaria and treated them for free. A day later she followed up, and all of my boys were healed."



Over the last four years, IH and World Centric have created long-lasting impact for women and children in Togo by expanding to a new district each year. In July of 2021, IH will expand to the Binah district with supporting funds from World Centric's 2020 profits.

PROJECT: Assisting restaurant workers out of work due to the pandemic

ALLOCATION: \$8,170 | FISCAL YEAR: 2020



Financial Assistance

The restaurant and hospitality industries are the largest in the country by a magnitude of 2x, and combined they are growing faster than any other industry. Yet, this industry is composed of people from some of the most vulnerable groups: single parents, LGBTQ, at-risk teens, immigrants, and ex-felons trying to turn

their lives around. And, the majority of foodservice workers are part of the working poor - one in six don't earn enough to put them above the US poverty line, double that of any other working population in any other industry.

The industry also sees the highest rates of people struggling with alcohol and drug addiction, divorce, job instability, rapid turnover, and almost no safety net. But because this is the hospitality industry, foodservice workers must keep smiles on their faces to greet the rest of us. Because of this, their needs are often overlooked.



In 2020, over 2.1 million foodservice and hospitality workers lost their jobs as a result of the pandemic. Big Table and Another Round, Another Rally are two nonprofits helping support these workers in our industry.

Big Table cares for restaurant and hospitality workers before they fall off the ledge by building community and caring for those in crisis, transition, or those just falling through the cracks.

This care is given through a referral model - Big Table builds a network of managers, owners and employees across the industry in Spokane, San Diego and Seattle. When a foodservice worker sees a

With a donation of \$3,910 from World Centric's 2020 staff giving program, Big Table will be able to provide hospitality workers in crisis with immediate relief grants. Big Table's holistic approach to care also provides longterm support for workers even after their initial crisis has passed. This includes coaching and mentoring, and connecting those in need with local resources (doctors, dentists, therapists, lawyers, etc).


Another Round, Another Rally provides \$500 reimbursement grants and immersive educational scholarships to further the education of underrepresented voices in the community, and supply emergency assistance to those employed in

restaurants, bars, and hotels who have fallen on unexpected hardship.

Half of grants disbursed in 2020 were given to undocumented hospitality workers who are unable to receive unemployment assistance. With a donation of \$4,260 from World Centric's 2020 staff giving program, Another Round, Another Rally will be able to provide immediate relief to the workers who are the backbone of our industry.

Las Olas partners with The Compost Group to divert food waste from landfills

Our society has an urgent need for more widespread commercial composting facilities to keep food waste out of landfills, where it does harm to the environment by releasing methane, one of the most potent greenhouse gases.

Across North America, many restaurants are discovering small-scale community composters that are stepping up to help local residents and foodservice operators reduce their waste.

One such restaurant, Las Olas with two locations in San Diego, has partnered with The Compost Group to become the first full service restaurant in North County San Diego to compost food waste. Each year, Las Olas is able to compost 15,000 pounds of food waste and compostable packaging through The Compost Group.

According to their website, "we do everything we can to be an environmentally conscious operation in an effort to protect "la tierra" (the land), and "las olas" (the waves)." Plus, Las Olas uses only compostable foodservice ware for take-out operations, recycles all cooking oil to help fuel local school buses, and hosts yearly community beach cleanups.

A strong advocate for environmental and city developmental issues, Las Olas has been leading the way in sustainability and setting an example for the local community on how to run a business and respect the environment since 1981.



Naomi Wentworth is the founder of The Compost Group in San Diego. Frustrated by the lack of composting options for food waste in San Diego County, and with a background in climate policy, Naomi saw an opportunity to start a business picking up food scraps from local restaurants and residential communities and composting them.

"Moving into an apartment in Encinitas where I could not compost in my backyard, I would just feel my heart sink every time I put those beautiful coffee grounds, egg shells, and vegetable trimmings into the garbage to go to landfill," explains Naomi. "I started The Compost Group because I was frustrated by the amount of food waste being sent to landfills in my community."

The Compost Group is helping divert food scraps and compostable packaging from landfills. In 2020 alone, they turned 59,187 pounds of organic waste into soil.



1. Sustainable Materials


Our materials are chosen for their sustainability. For example, molded fiber products are made from annually renewable plants such as sugarcane bagasse and wheat straw which also sequester carbon while growing and are agricultural by-products.

2. Reduce Waste

When commercial composting is available, our foodservice ware diverts waste from the landfill and composts in 2-4 months. Plastic containers contaminated with food are rarely recycled. Expanded polystyrene easily becomes litter due to its light weight, and is also challenging to recycle. It is estimated that only 9% of all plastic ever created has been recycled.

3. Less Energy

Our products require less energy to produce than petroleum-based products, which reduces greenhouse gas emissions, lessening the impact of climate change.
